Covid-19 Christmas Plan

Up to and including the 24th December should your child test positive for Covid-19 you must inform Mrs Tyrer by email head@burscoughbridge.lancs.sch.uk.

Mrs Tyrer will then use the schools text messaging service to inform any children and staff who have been in close contact to self-isolate. It is important that we have your up-to-date contact phone number.

After the 24th December anyone who tests positive or is required to self-isolate due to contact with a positive case, please follow the normal Track & Trace procedures. It is not necessary to inform school until the first day of the new term - 4^{th} January 2021.


Primary School Applications
