MATHS - making dragons out of different pre-cut shapes and discussing

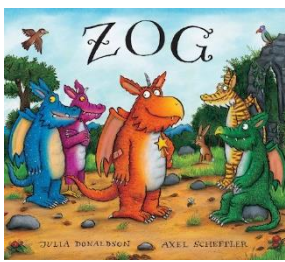
ROLE PLAY - rescue from a dragon/knight in shining armour

MATHS - dragon repeated pattern

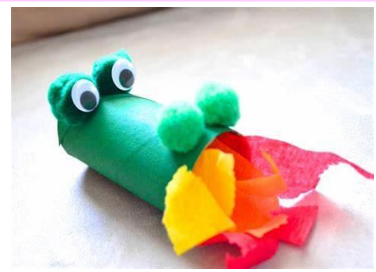
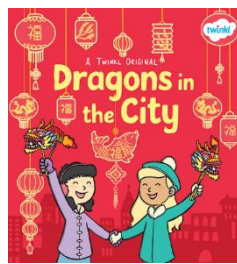


PD - laminated dragon teeth with spots/lines (whiteboard pen), children should clean with toothbrushes and discuss oral health
