Planning in the Moment will be our main way of teaching and learning. Additional activities will be introduced when relevant or necessary.






WRITING describing a dragon egg

ARTS -Chinese Dragon song (twinkl)


ARTS - dragon dancing

UOTW - Chinese New Year Playdough




ARTS - junk model The Great Wall of China
