Second Hand Uniform

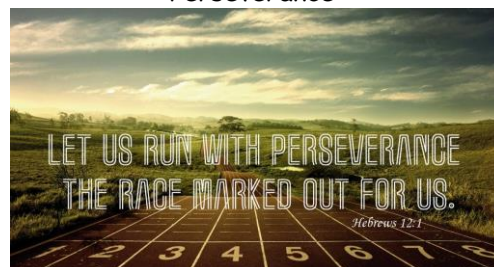
We have a large selection of second hand school uniform in the office. It is in very good condition and everybody is welcome to take any items.
