Attendance and Punctuality

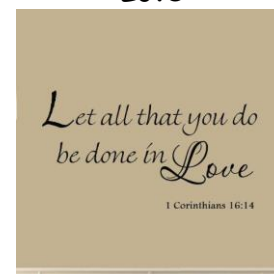
