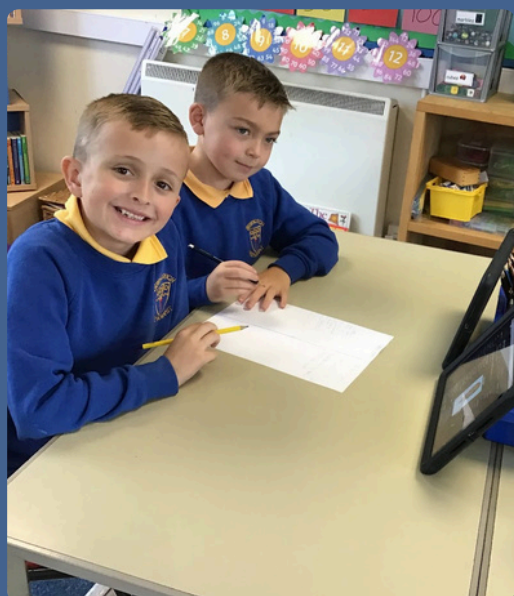

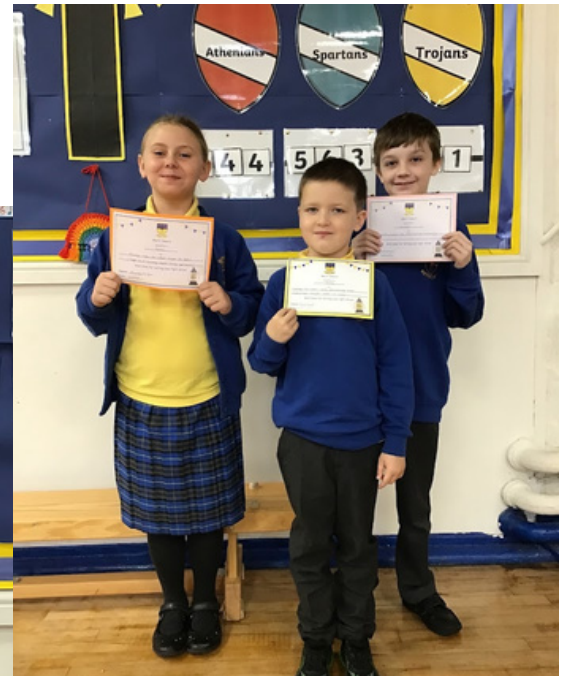
COLLECTIVE WORSHIP
