GAINING NEW KNOWLEDGE

This week at Forest School, the children embraced a range of outdoor challenges and teamwork opportunities. They practised their balance and co-ordination on the slack line, worked together to gather pine branches and constructed a shelter to protect themselves from the wind and also built a small fire and enjoyed roasting apple slices for a tasty woodland snack.



GAINING NEW KNOWLEDGE

This week in Science, **Year 3 and Year 4** have been exploring electrical circuits. The children built their own circuits, experimented with different components, and successfully got their bulbs to light up. They discussed the role of each element in a circuit and gained an understanding of how electricity flows.

This week in Maths, **Year 5 and Year 6** have been learning about BODMAS, the order of operations used to solve calculations accurately. BODMAS stands for Brackets, Other operations, Division, Multiplication, Addition and Subtraction. The children have been applying this rule to work through problems, can you solve $12 \times 4 + 6$?
