GAINING NEW KNOWLEDGE



This week in Maths **Years 3 and 4** have been learning how to measure length using metres, centimetres and millimetres. They carried out practical investigations, including finding out who was the tallest in the class and who had the largest head circumference. They then presented their results by creating a bar chart to show their findings.

This week in Science, **Years 5 and 6** explored how some traits are inherited from parents while others are adapted over time to help living things survive. They compared different examples and discussed how these traits develop in humans, animals, and plants.
